FIELD NOTES FOR TONKAWA LAKE, INC.:

BEING 7.25 acres of land out of the William Kincaid Survey, Abstract No. 374 in Williamson County, Texas. Said land also being out of a certain 170.21-acre tract conveyed by deed from Round Rock Lime Co. to Jack Garey, of record in Volume 646, Page 12 of the Deed Records of Williamson County, Texas. Surveyed on the ground in the month of January, 1977 by Don H. Bizzell, Registered Professional Engineer, and described more fully as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the South margin of Sam Bass Road. Said point being S 66° 06' E, 524.65 feet and S 88° 07' E, 705.22 feet from the N.W. corner of the said 170.21-acre tract. Said point also being the N.W. corner of a certain 4.15-acre tract conveyed by deed from the Round Rock Lime Co., to Ray Yates, of record in Volume 594, Page 383 of the Deed Records of Williamson County, Texas. Said point also being S 55° 38' E, 1753 feet from the N.W. corner of the said Kincaid Survey, for the N.E. corner hereof;

THENCE, along the South margin of Sam Bass Road, N 88° 07' W, 705.22 feet and N 66° 06' W, 3.27 feet to an iron pin set at the beginning of a curve to the left (R = 20.00 feet);

THENCE, along the said curve (long chord bears S 51° 56' W, 35.31 feet), a distance of 43.26 feet to an iron pin set at the end of the said curve;

THENCE S 10° 02' E, 165.63 feet to an iron pin set at the beginning of a curve (R = 537.25 feet);

THENCE, along the said curve (long chord bears S 20° 07' E, 188.15 feet), a distance of 189.13 feet to an iron pin set at the end of the said curve;

THENCE S 30° 12' E, 279.21 feet to an iron pin set for the S.W. corner hereof;

THENCE N 59° 56' E, 423.74 feet to an iron pin set;

THENCE N 72° 07' E, 200.36 feet to an iron pin found at the most westerly S.W. corner of the said 4.15-acre tract, for the S.E. corner hereof;

THENCE, along the West line of the said 4.15-acre tract, as follows:

N 20° 54' W, 191.42 feet to an iron pin found; and

N 05° 38' E, 126.35 feet to the Place of BEGINNING and containing 7.25 acres of land.
