PLASTICS #1-#7:

beverage bottles, spray bottles, milk jugs, food tubs

FLATTENED CARDBOARD:

food packaging, paper towel rolls, moving boxes

GLASS:

beverage bottles, food jars

ALUMINUM & METAL:

beverage cans, food cans, foil
