- Expected Completion—Spring 2023
- This project improves the intersection of Great Oaks Dr and Brushy Creek/Hairy Man Road by improving traffic flow and raising the bridge to prevent flooding.

### **Progress this Week:**

- DeNucci Constructors:
  - Continued forming and pouring the cast-in-place retaining wall panels and footings on the north side of the parking lot under the bridge.
  - Poured concrete in the pipe bollards in parking lot under the bridge.
  - Excavated for and placed stone riprap on the north side of Brushy Creek.
  - Cut and sealed the joints in the concrete pavement on the south section of parking lot under the bridge.
  - Installed conduit for the traffic signal poles on the northeast and southwest corners of the intersection.
  - Began clearing excavating the north bank of Brushy Creek, east and west of the bridge.
  - Began installing the storm sewer pipe on the west side of southbound Great Oaks Drive.
  - Continued placing the embankment on the west side of southbound Great Oaks Drive.

- Subcontractor Greater Austin:
  - Set forms, tied steel, and poured the Phase 4 portion of the bridge caps.

## Work Scheduled:

- DeNucci Constructors:
  - Continue placing earthwork embankment at the southwest corner of the bridge.
  - Continue cast-in-place retaining wall construction along north side of Brushy Creek Road.
  - Continue retaining wall construction at northwest corner of the intersection.
  - Continue parking lot construction.
- Subcontractor Greater Austin
  - Continue Phase 4 bridge construction for Great Oaks Bridge.

### Lane Closures:

• Temporary daily lane closures are anticipated to provide a safe work zone.

### **General Notes:**

- Watch for construction equipment entering and exiting work zones, within project limits.
- All work mentioned above is contingent upon weather conditions.
